The Role

The Workshop Manager will be required to organize and direct a team in order to deliver a top quality product, with a prompt, accurate and personalized service in a dynamic work environment.

Key duties and responsibilities:

- Responsible for the upkeep and maintenance of all golf maintenance machinery in addition to frequently spot checking equipment for performance on the course
- Supervises and diagnoses problems on light and heavy maintenance equipment
- Utilizes proper servicing methods for golf course equipment and mechanical equipment including the repair and adjustment of power mowing equipment, spin grinding reels and back lapping bed knives
- Manages and supervises a team of mechanics including hiring, determining workload and delegating assignments, training, monitoring performance evaluation and initiating corrective and disciplinary actions.
- Maintains the overall responsibility for inventory control of equipment parts, shop supplies, repair tools and assists the crew with equipment operation training
- Oversees the shop maintenance area and maintains a working knowledge of hazards and safety precautions of the profession
- Manages accounting or budgeting activities and provides financial reports

- A Bachelor's degree in golf management, management or a related field along with a minimum of 10 years' experience as a Head Mechanic, with 5 or more years being at a multi-course facility (more than 18 holes) in a management role.
- Knowledge and skills of theory, principles and practice of golf machinery maintenance including complete knowledge and understanding of the reel-cutting, Toro and Textron equipment maintenance programmes.
- Ability to work inside/outside in all types of weather conditions as well as have an excellent work attitude and quality work
- Good computer skills and experience using a computer-based equipment management software programmes such as Trimms, TurfCentric and MyTurf.
- Good communication, people management and interpersonal skills.
